



**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD

Awarding Bid for Food Service at River Valley Juvenile Center

WHEREAS, in order to receive the most competitive price available, the Will County Executive's Office solicited bids for food service for River Valley Juvenile Center, and

WHEREAS, after reviewing such proposals, the River Valley Juvenile Center Director, with approval from the Illinois State Board of Education, recommends the bid be awarded to Aramark Correctional Services, of Downers Grove, IL, for an approximate annual amount of \$156,266.88. This cost will fluctuate based upon population. This amount is based on an average daily population of forty-two (42), for three (3) meals and two (2) snacks per day. This contract will begin August 3, 2015 and continue through and including August 2, 2016, with two (2) additional one (1) year optional renewals, if the County so chooses, and

WHEREAS, the Executive Committee concurs with this bid award and recommends approval to the full County Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Will County Board hereby awards the bid to Aramark Correctional Services, of Downers Grove, IL, for an approximate annual amount of \$156,266.88. This cost will fluctuate based upon population. This amount is based on an average daily population of forty-two (42), for three (3) meals and two (2) snacks per day. This contract will begin August 3, 2015 and continue through and including August 2, 2016, with two (2) additional one (1) year optional renewals, if the County so chooses.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Preamble of this Resolution is hereby adopted as if fully set forth herein. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval as provided by law.



The River Valley Detention Center is requesting to be placed on the June 11, 2015, Executive Committee agenda. The Detention Center's food service contract for three one-year renewals expires in August, 2015. As a result, the Detention Center sought Invitations for Bid for a new contract beginning August 3, 2015. The Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) established the bid protocol to be followed for the bid process in tandem with the County of Will's procedures. The bid was published on April 23, 2015, and the bid opening was on May 19, 2015. One company presented a bid at the opening, to wit: Aramark Correctional Services.

After reviewing the bids, the River Valley Detention Center, with approval from the Illinois State Board of Education, recommends the bid be awarded to Aramark Correctional Services, Downers Grove, IL, for the first year annual estimated amount of \$156,266.88 for all meals and snacks.
