

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS

Authorizing Extension of Contract for Security Guard Services

WHEREAS, the current contract with Permar Security Services, Westchester, IL for security guard service at various county buildings expired on November 30, 2015, and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Director has the authority to negotiate a 30-day extension of said contract, which has been done, and

WHEREAS, the Executive Committee recommended a six (6) month extension to the current contract with Permar Security Services, Westchester, IL, from January 1, 2016 through and including June 30, 2016, which has been done, and

WHEREAS, in order to allow adequate time for evaluations of assessments being conducted by an outside consultant to take place, the Executive Committee recommends an additional five (5) month extension to the current contract with Permar Security Services, Westchester, IL, from July 1, 2016 through and including November 30, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Will County Board hereby authorizes an additional five (5) month extension to the current contract with Permar Security Services, Westchester, IL, for security guard service at various county buildings from July 1, 2016 through and including November 30, 2016.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this contract shall be subject to the review and approval of the Will County State's Attorney's Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Preamble of this Resolution is hereby adopted as if fully set forth herein. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval as provided by law.

AMENDMENT THREE TO AGREEMENT FOR SECURITY SERVICES BY AND BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF WILL IN THE STATE OF ILLINOIS AND PER MAR SECURITY SERVICES, WESTCHESTER, IL

This Amendment is made effective the 1st day of July, 2016 by and between the County of Will in the State of Illinois, specifically the County Executive, and Per Mar Security Services, Westchester, IL.

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an Agreement for Security Guard Services as of December 21, 2012 (the "Agreement") and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the term of the Agreement and amend its terms and conditions, as set forth below.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual agreements as herein set forth, the parties agree as follows:

- All terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force except as specifically amended herein.
- Contract shall be amended to extend the term of the Agreement for a period of six (6)
 months, July 1, 2016 through and including November 30, 2016.
- 3. Monthly billing shall continue at the current rate, as of the date of this signed amendment.
- 4. This extension shall cover the following locations: County Office Building, 302 N. Chicago Street, Joliet, IL, 60432; Sunny Hill Nursing Home, 421 Doris Avenue, Joliet, IL, 60433; Adult Probation, 57 N Ottawa Street, Joliet, IL, 60432; and Workforce Services, 2400 Glenwood Avenue, Joliet, IL, 60435.
