**ADDENDUM #1**

We received the following questions regarding the bid listed above:

Question # 1: Our company custom builds each unit. Every phase of our production is conducted by specialists in the fabrication and assembly processes. Your proposed vehicle will require the same manufacturing processes we have utilized for over 20 years. While we cannot give you 12 "similar chassis" units, we could certainly provide you with indicators of our past performance in the same fabrication/manufacturing processes that would give you an indicator of our expertise.

**Answer #1: Please provide past performance information which will be reviewed for similar chassis units.**

Question #2: As a small company, we could not delay the receipt of payment until the project is completed. Our terms would be 1/3 down at purchase order; 1/3 at a mutually agreed-upon mid-point; and, 1/3 at final acceptance.

**Answer #2: Payment terms as stated in the bid document are "upon completion of the contract".**

Question #3: Our personnel are experts in diagnostics and repair; and, have industry-wide connections that would minimize down-time. While we would assure the fastest turn around possible, we may have no control of availability and could not guarantee a 5 day repair. Additionally, by design, we do not have a loaner to provide if repairs cannot be completed within 5 days.

**Answer #3: Per stipulations in the bid document, no exceptions will be made to the following requirements:**

**Repairs by the Contractor**

*If the County requires the Contractor to perform the warranty repair, the Contractor, at its own expense, will provide all parts, tools, labor and space required for completing the repair. Contractor must complete warranty repairs within 5 working days of initial notification by the Owner of such needed repair work. If work cannot be completed, Contractor must supply, at their expense, a loaner vehicle, until County's vehicle is repaired and returned. The loaner vehicle must be similarly equipped to the Owner's vehicle, and all transfer of equipment from the Owner's vehicle to the loaner vehicle is the responsibility of the Contractor. Upon return of the Owner's vehicle, all transfer of equipment from the loaner vehicle to the Owner's vehicle is the responsibility of the Contractor. The County shall bear no responsibility for any costs related to the transfer of equipment in the manner stated above.*
