



**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD
WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

Awarding Bid for Body Armor for Sheriff's Department

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Will County's Sheriff's Department to be equipped and ready for dangerous situations, and

WHEREAS, in order to obtain the most competitive rates for body armor, proposals were solicited, and

WHEREAS, on February 11, 2016, the County Executive's Office opened six (6) proposals for the purchase of body armor, and

WHEREAS, after intense review, the Sheriff's Department has recommended to split the bid award to KIESLER POLICE SUPPLY (KPS), JEFFERSONVILLE, IN, for the purchase of ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS (EO) VESTS and to STREICHER'S, PLYMOUTH, MN, for purchase of CORRECTIONS OFFICERS (CO) VESTS. This is an approximate annual amount of \$26,680.50 to KPS, for purchase of +/- 50 EO VESTS per year at a cost of \$533.61 EACH, and an approximate annual amount of \$34,450.00; to STREICHER'S for purchase of +/- 50 CO VESTS per year at a cost of \$689.00 EACH. This will be a three (3) year contract, with effective dates of June 1, 2016 through and including May 30, 2019, and

WHEREAS, the Judicial Committee has concurred with this recommendation, with necessary funding available in the Sheriff's Budget.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Will County Board hereby awards the contract to provide body armor for the Sheriff's Department to Kiesler Police Supply (KPS), Jeffersonville, IN, for the purchase of Enforcement Officers (EO) vests and to Streicher's, Plymouth, MN, for purchase of Corrections Officers (CO) vests. This is an approximate annual amount of \$26,680.50 to KPS, for purchase of +/- 50 EO vests per year at a cost of \$533.61 each, and an approximate annual amount of \$34,450.00 to Streicher's for purchase of +/- 50 CO vests per year at a cost of \$689.00 each. This will be a three (3) year contract, with effective dates of June 1, 2016 through and including May 30, 2019.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Preamble of this Resolution is hereby adopted as if fully set forth herein. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval as provided by law.



Rita:

Upon reviewing the submitted bids (Contract for #2016-23 Sheriff Body Armor) and/or completing our testing, we have enclosed our recommendation. Please see below for further;

1st Responder Equipment, Inc.: (KDH Defense Systems)

Prices too high compared to the others that were received.

JCM Uniform, Inc.: (Survival Armor)

Enforcement (Paragon6 Model # LW-II)

Stated in paragraph 7 of the Technical Specifications-Enforcement Officers: "In addition the body armor must be capable of stopping the following ammunition (See table below); proof of compliance must be completed prior to the bid and submitted with the bid." The "Special Rounds" indicated in the bid were for the following;

- Winchester 180 gr. T-Series
- Winchester 9mm Luger, 127 gr. +P+ SXT (Velocity: 1,340 ft/s +/- 30 ft/s)
- Speer .357 Sig 125 gr. GDHP (Velocity: 1,465 ft/s +/- 30 ft/s)

Though the "Special Threat testing" results for the first two were received and found to be in compliance. The information provided for the .357 was for the incorrect bullet type (.357 Sig 125 gr. TMJ) which reported lower velocity than we

were asking for) we were seeking the information for regarding the "Special Threat testing".

Corrections (Cancelable Combination Armor Model # BIIS-2)

Stated in paragraph 7 of the Technical Specifications-Correctional Officers: "In addition the body armor must be capable of stooping the following ammunition (See table below); proof of compliance must be completed prior to the bid and submitted with the bid." The "Special Rounds" indicated in the bid were for the following:

- Winchester 180 gr. T-Series
- Winchester 9mm Luger, 127 gr. +P+ SXT (Velocity: 1,340 ft/s +/- 30 ft/s)
- Speer .357 Sig 125 gr. GDHP (Velocity: 1,465 ft/s +/- 30 ft/s)

No Special Threat testing results were included.

Ray O'Herron Co., Inc. (Point Blank)

Corrections. (Ballistic-Spike Combo Model # CB-S2-BII-1)

Stated in paragraph 7 of the Technical Specifications-Correctional Officers: "In addition the body armor must be capable of stooping the following ammunition (See table below); proof of compliance must be completed prior to the bid and submitted with the bid." The "Special Rounds" indicated in the bid were for the following:

- Winchester 180 gr. T-Series
- Winchester 9mm Luger, 127 gr. +P+ SXT (Velocity: 1,340 ft/s +/- 30 ft/s)
- Speer .357 Sig 125 gr. GDHP (Velocity: 1,465 ft/s +/- 30 ft/s)

No Special Threat testing results were included.

Ray O'Herron Co., Inc. (Armor Express)

Enforcement: (Vortex Gen2)

Meets all requirements.

Corrections: (Gemini Dual Purpose Armor)

Stated in paragraph 7 of the Technical Specifications-Enforcement Officers: "In addition the body armor must be capable of stooping the following ammunition (See table below); proof of compliance must be completed prior to the bid and

submitted with the bid.” The “Special Rounds” indicated in the bid were for the following:

- Winchester 180 gr. T-Series
- Winchester 9mm Luger, 127 gr. +P+ SXT (Velocity: 1,340 ft/s +/- 30 ft/s)
- Speer .357 Sig 125 gr. GDHP (Velocity: 1,465 ft/s +/- 30 ft/s)

Only submitted Special Threat testing results for the Winchester 180 gr. T-Series and not for the other two rounds.

Kiesler Police Supply, Inc. (Armor Express)

Enforcement: (Vortex Gen2)

Meets all requirements.

Corrections: (Gemini Dual Purpose Armor)

Stated in paragraph 7 of the Technical Specifications-Enforcement Officers: “In addition the body armor must be capable of stooping the following ammunition (See table below); proof of compliance must be completed prior to the bid and submitted with the bid.” The “Special Rounds” indicated in the bid were for the following:

- Winchester 180 gr. T-Series
- Winchester 9mm Luger, 127 gr. +P+ SXT (Velocity: 1,340 ft/s +/- 30 ft/s)
- Speer .357 Sig 125 gr. GDHP (Velocity: 1,465 ft/s +/- 30 ft/s)

Only submitted Special Threat testing results for the Winchester 180 gr. T-Series and not for the other two rounds.

Streicher's Inc. (ABA Body Armor & Second Chance Body Armor)

Enforcement: (ABA Body Armor-Xtreme Model # BA-2000S-XT03)

Stated in paragraph 7 of the Technical Specifications-Enforcement Officers: “In addition the body armor must be capable of stooping the following ammunition (See table below); proof of compliance must be completed prior to the bid and submitted with the bid.” The “Special Rounds” indicated in the bid were for the following:

- Winchester 180 gr. T-Series
- Winchester 9mm Luger, 127 gr. +P+ SXT (Velocity: 1,340 ft/s +/- 30 ft/s)
- Speer .357 Sig 125 gr. GDHP (Velocity: 1,465 ft/s +/- 30 ft/s)

Indicated on the Technical Specifications page, included with the bid, it states under "Additional Special Threat" that the Winchester 9mm 127 gr. +P+ SXT round and Speer .357 125 gr. GDHP were both tested with "No Perforations", however, does not indicated/include anything regarding the Winchester 180 gr. T-Series round.

Corrections: (Second Chance-Prism MT Model # MS-2020S-MT22.1)

Meets all requirements.

Based on review of the enclosed documents submitted with the bid's we found that only one vest for the Enforcement Division (Armor Express Model Vortex Gen II) and one vest for the Correctional Division (Second Chance-Prism MT Model #MS-2020S-MT22.1) had all the required criteria/paperwork that was requested submitted along with their bid. We have tested both vest and are satisfied with the results. The vest that did not meet the criteria were not tested and returned to manufacture if they requested the vest be returned. Therefore, for the Enforcement Division we would like to purchase the Armor Express (Vortex Gen II) and for the Corrections Division we would like to purchase the Second Chance-Prism MT (Model #MS-2020S-MT22.1) through Streicher's Inc.

Both Ray O'Herron and Kiesler Police Supply, Inc., submitted bids for the Armor Express Model Vortex Gen II vest. Ray O'Herron quoted a higher price and did not acknowledge receipt of the 2nd Addendum (February 4, 2016). Therefore, we would request purchasing the Enforcement Division vest through Kiesler Police Supply.
