We received the following questions regarding this bid. Please note no further questions will be accepted or responded to as this bid is due December 1, 2022 at 1:00 PM:

Question # 1: What is the evaluation criteria for the RFP?

Answer # 1: Per the Will County Purchasing Ordinance award will be given to the lowest responsible bidder that meets all of the qualification requirements listed within the RFP.

Question # 2: Is there an asset inventory of fleet that Will County is able to provide?

Answer # 2: A fully detailed list, including make, model and year will be provided to the selected consultant. Broadly please see the chart attached for a type and count of the fleet inventory.

Question # 3: What contract type will be applied for the work described in this request for proposals?

Answer # 3: A standard contract for consulting services can be expected.

Question # 4: In executing Task 3, data may be required from the utility to characterize existing electric capacity in Will County for EV charging. Does the county currently hold this data, or is it expected that the consultant will engage with the utility to obtain it?

Answer # 4: Consultant will engage with the utility(ies).

Question # 5: In Task 6 should the cost of the transition be estimated using the AFLEET tool or may a custom Excel model be used?

Answer # 5: AFLEET tool or a similar approach



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Question # 6: Regarding the Current Conditions Assessment, should this EV charging infrastructure question focus on the County and/or include the broader question of the region's capacities?

Answer # 6: Both

Question # 7: Existing utility capacity – is this for the entire county, region and/or for specific County facilities?

Answer # 7: If possible, both.

Question # 8: To assess a current condition for the County, we assume this includes all county facilities and vehicles. How should we estimate these populations in order to quote? For example in order to assess fleet actions, we believe we would need fleet data – types of vehicles, usage case, etc. As well, the facilities would need to be assessed in order to determine suitability for adding infrastructure. How to quantify?

Answer # 8: Please see question 2 for response, the County will provide access to the information.

Question # 9: For this plan, is Will County considering Level 2 or Level 3 charging stations or both?
