We received the following questions regarding this bid:

Question # 1: Please provide profiles for each hazardous waste stream

Answer # 1: This is a new facility. No profiles or samples exist from this facility.

Question # 2: Please provide annual volumes and shipment frequencies for each waste stream

Answer # 2: Waste oil removal and disposal will need to be completed approximately every 3 to 6 months. Annual volume of waste oil could be as much as 2,000 gallons. Activated carbon is utilized on site as filter media for removal of contaminants from landfill gas. Filter media will be sampled & analyzed prior to removal/disposal by operations and maintenance contractor. Up to 100 cubic yards of used Darco BG1 carbon filter media for the hydrogen sulfide removal system will need to be removed off-site approximately every 5 months. The silica gel from the media dryer system will need to be removed about every 2 to 4 years. Approximately 58,000 pounds of dry silica gel is within onsite vessel. Wastes determined to be hazardous waste will need to be transported and disposed off-site. If determined to be non-hazardous, they may be disposed at landfill adjacent to facility. Note that these volumes, weights, and timeframes are estimates and not to be considered exact numbers.

Question # 3: Approximately how many emergency responses were performed in 2021 and year to date and if possible describe the emergency?

Answer # 3: Zero. This is a new facility. A potential emergency could be a gas condensate spill on the property due to an accident during off-loading from onsite tanks into our condensate haulers tanker trailer.

Question # 4: Is there any equipment that is utilized onsite on an ongoing basis, if yes, please provide a list detailing the types and number of pieces currently used?



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Answer # 4: No mobile or heavy equipment is currently utilized onsite on an ongoing basis related to hazardous waste management & disposal purposes. Cranes or fork lifts will be utilized on site as needed by our operations & maintenance contractor for process equipment work and filter media change outs

Question # 5: Are any of the personnel onsite on an ongoing basis, or only utilized when an emergency response occurs or when there is a need for a waste disposal pickup?

Answer # 5: Personnel is expected to only be needed when an emergency response occurs or when there is a need for waste management disposal services)
