Awarding Bid for Food Service at River Valley Juvenile Center

WHEREAS, in order to receive the most competitive price available, the Will County Executive's Office solicited proposals for food service for River Valley Juvenile Center, and

WHEREAS, after reviewing such proposals, the River Valley Juvenile Center Superintendent, with approval from the Illinois State Board of Education, recommends the bid be awarded to Aramark Correctional Services of Downers Grove, IL, for an approximate annual amount of \$230,789.04. This cost will fluctuate based upon population. This amount is based on an average daily population of forty-two (42) for three (3) meals and two (2) snacks per day. This contract will begin August 3, 2023 and continue through and including August 2, 2024, with two (2) additional one (1) year optional renewals, if the County so chooses, and

WHEREAS, the Public Health & Public Safety Committee concurs with this bid award and recommends approval to the full County Board.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Will County Board hereby awards the bid to Aramark Correctional Services of Downers Grove, IL, for an approximate annual amount of \$230,789.04. This cost will fluctuate based upon population. This amount is based on an average daily population of forty-two (42) for three (3) meals and two (2) snacks per day. This contract will begin August 3, 2023 and continue through and including August 2, 2024, with two (2) additional one (1) year optional renewals, if the County so chooses.




Re: Food Service Bid

Dear County Board,

The River Valley Detention Center is requesting to be placed on the appropriate Committee Agenda. The Detention Center's one-year Emergency Re-Bid Agreement expires in August 2023. As a result, the Detention Center sought Invitations for Bid for a new contract beginning August 3, 2023. The Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) established the bid protocol to be followed for the bid process in tandem with the County of Will's procedures. The bid was published on April 3, 2023, and the opening was on May 18, 2023. Two companies presented a two-option bid each at the opening, to wit: Aramark Correctional Services and Trinity Services Group.

After reviewing the bids, the River Valley Detention Center, with approval from the Illinois State Board of Education, recommends the bid be awarded to Aramark Correctional Services, Downers Grove, IL, Option 2 for the first year annual estimated amount of \$230,789.04 for all meals and snacks. Revisions cannot be made to the executed *Invitation for Bid and Contract or Request for Proposal* without first submitting proposed revisions to the ISBE for review and receiving notification the proposed revisions are allowable. Furthermore, additional documents and/or agreements including those developed by the contractor cannot become part of the executed contract, unless otherwise approved by ISBE.

All procurement transactions must be conducted in compliance with the Conflict-of-Interest standards and requirements included in 2 CFR 200.112 and 2 CFR 200.318. All procurement transactions must be conducted in a manner providing full and open competition consistent with the standards of 2 CFR 200.319. In order to ensure objective contractor performance and eliminate unfair competitive advantage, contractors that developed or drafted specifications requirements, statements of work, or invitations for bids or requests for proposals must be excluded from competing for this procurement.

Following the contract award, you must submit, via email to nutritionprocurement@isbe.net, the enclosed *Post-Contract Award Summary Sheet* along with all requested documentation noted on the form. The form is available online at <https://www.isbe.net/Pages/SNP-FSMC-Vended-Meals-Contracts.aspx> and is interactive. Once submitted, the documents will be reviewed, you will receive written notification have concluded the solicitation process and may proceed with using Child Nutrition Program funds to pay for the awarded contract.
