

## Stormwater Management Committee Awards Grants for 2010 Projects

The Will County Stormwater Management Planning Committee awarded the 2010 Project Grants to recipients. Five projects were selected county wide which included a mix of flood mitigation and water quality improvement projects.

“The Stormwater Committee is grateful that the County Board continues to support and fund this project program” said Scott Killinger, who chairs the Committee. “The projects funded this year will benefit the citizens of Will County by improving water quality in our streams, and by mitigating flooding in neighborhoods.”

This is the second year of the program. The Stormwater Project Program awards grant funds of up to 50% for projects that include flood mitigation and water quality improvement. Will County received five applications this year from five different local sponsors. The selected projects include:

- Hammel Creek Bank Stabilization, Village of Shorewood
- Round Barn Buffer Enhancement, Manhattan Twp
- Harris Drive Drainage Study, Plainfield Twp
- Thorn Creek Drainage Study, Village of Park Forest
- Stone Bridge Park Bank Stabilization, New Lenox Twp
