

## Stormwater Management Committee Awards Grants for 2018 Projects

The Will County Stormwater Management Planning Committee awarded the 2018 Project Grants to recipients at their regular meeting on Tuesday April 3, 2018. Ten projects were selected county wide which included a mix of flood mitigation and water quality improvement projects.

“The Stormwater Committee is grateful that the County Board continues to support and fund this project program” said John Dykstra, Chair of the Committee. “The projects funded this year will benefit the citizens of Will County by improving water quality in our streams, and by mitigating flooding in neighborhoods.”

This is the tenth year of the program. The Stormwater Project Program awards grant funds of up to 50% for projects that include flood mitigation and water quality improvement. Will County received ten applications this year from nine different local sponsors. The Will County Board budgeted \$150,000 for 2018 and the Stormwater Management Planning Committee was able to award all of it. The selected projects include:

- US Army Corps of Engineers, DuPage River Feasibility Study (multiyear project)
- Root Street Drainage (City of Crest Hill)
- Washington Street Streambank Stabilization (City of Joliet)
- Replace/maintain W Brittany Lane tile (Green Garden Township)
- Pilcher Park Erosion Management Project (Joliet Park District)
- Natures Crossing Drainage (Plainfield Park District)
- Countyline Road Ditching (Plainfield Township)
- Crystal Creek Streambank Stabilization (Village of Mokena)
- Main Street Storm Sewer Phase I (Village of Monee)
- Hickory Creek Streambank Stabilization (Village of New Lenox with NL VFW)
